## PREFACE

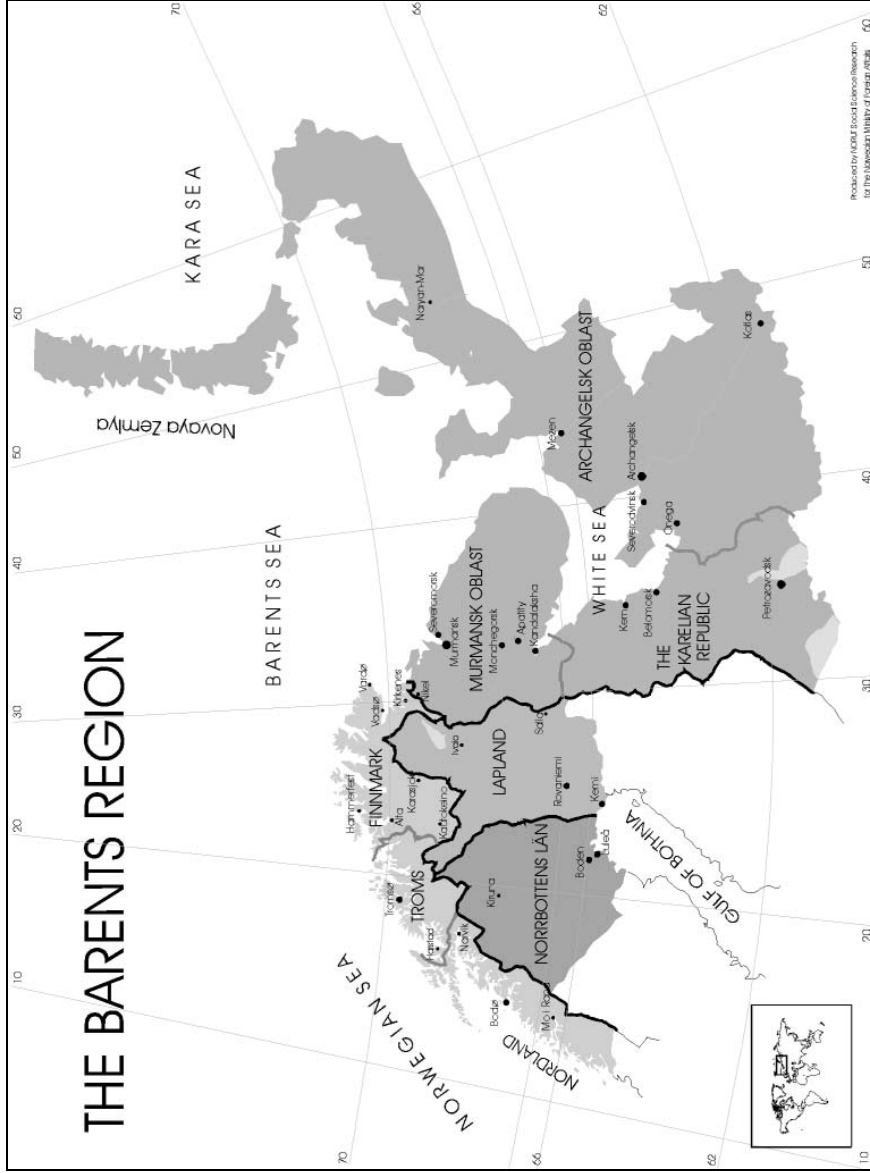
